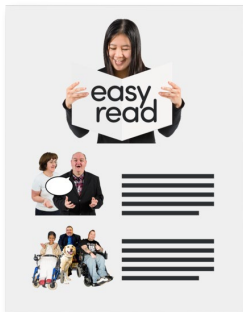

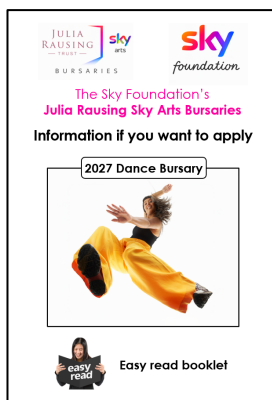
Who we are and what this booklet is about

This booklet is the Application Form for our bursary programme called the **Julia Rausing Sky Arts Bursaries**.

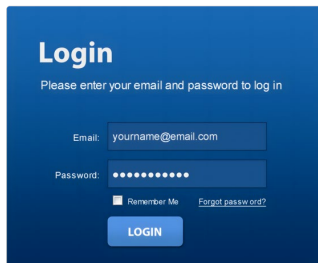


We wrote a different booklet about our bursary programme called **Information if you want to apply**.

When you have set up an account, you can fill out the Application Form.



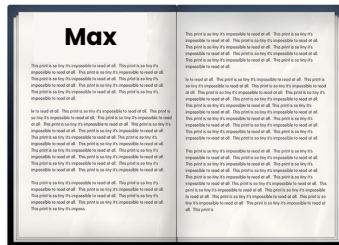
You do not have to fill out the Application Form all at once. You can fill out some parts, save it, and then fill out other parts later on.

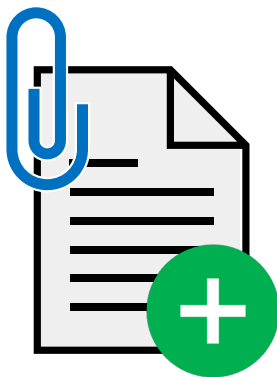

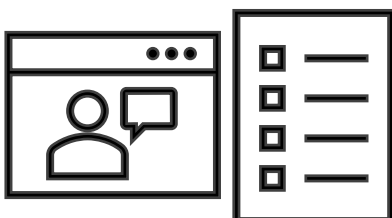
Maximum, or **max** for short, means the largest number allowed.

Videos must be

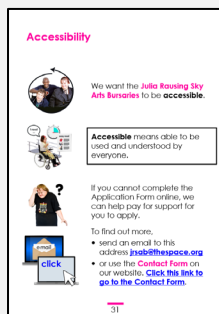
- 3 minutes long or less
- a file size that is 500MB or less
- a format called mp4 or mov.



Documents must be

- 5 pages long or less
- a file size that is 10MB or less
- a format called docx or pdf.

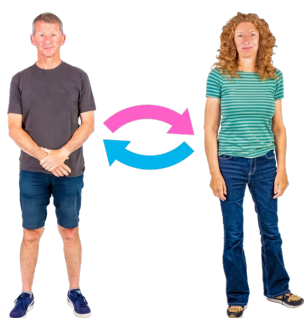
For **Question 6.4**, we will ask you to tell us about your **trans status**.

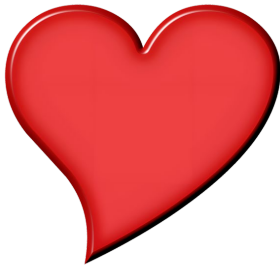

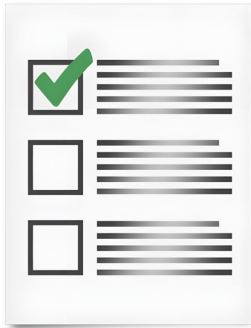

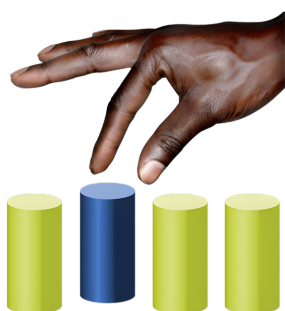


For the next tick box, we will ask you to give your **consent** for us to use the information in **Part 6** of the Application Form.
